When you register the glider in Manitoba for the first time, you must provide:

- If imported, proof the glider kit was properly imported into Canada
- Proof of ownership of the glider kit
- Periodic Mandatory Vehicle Inspection of main component parts
- Approval for Manitoba-Assigned Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) form
