## Protecting Your Investment from Rodent Damage

Maintaining the integrity, safety and resale value of your RV, motor home or trailer is important. That's why it's essential to take the appropriate measures to protect your investment from rodents.

- When parking for an extended period of time, avoid tall-grass areas, wooded areas or fields where rodents are more likely to be living.
- Whether it's leftover fast food, pet food or a few crumbs that fell on the fl oor, rodents are attracted to the scent. Be safe and don't keep any food inside your RV, motor home or trailer when not in use.
- When parking in a garage, seal up any holes on the outside of the building, lay out traps and ensure any food in the area is stored in a tightly sealed container.
- If you have a barbecue unit, remove it when not in use as rodents are attracted to the residual odour.
- If appropriate, seal up any identified points of entry to prevent rodents from easily getting inside your RV, motor home or trailer.
