



INSTRUCTOR PERMIT CONDITIONS

- Your driver's licence must be continuously valid.
- Your driving record cannot reflect more than two (2) convictions or more than two (2) at-fault accidents.
- Your driving record cannot indicate a suspension or prohibition from driving.
- Valid e-mail address must be provided to the Permit Unit and must be maintained.
- Any changes to your name, address, e-mail address or licence status must be reported directly to the Permit Unit.
- A Criminal Record Search is required to determine your eligibility to hold a permit.
- A Child Abuse Registry Check may be required to determine your eligibility to hold a permit.
- Complete renewal applications are required by March 31st of each year.
- If your permit expires, it cannot be *renewed*. All requirements need to be completed for a *new* permit.
- Instructors must be employed by a driving school in order to provide instruction.
- Only permitted training vehicles can be used for practical instruction.
- Driver training is not allowed on streets, parallel parking and backing areas that are used for driver testing purposes. This applies after hours, on weekends and holidays.
- You must not share, reproduce or copy the driver testing maps.
- You must not contravene the DVA, HTA or a regulation under either of these Acts.
- You must conduct yourself according to law and with integrity and honesty.
- A breach of one or more of these conditions may result in the cancellation, suspension or refusal of your permit.
- Sanctions imposed against your permit may be published on Manitoba Public Insurance's public website.
