



CLASS 2 & 3 VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

- Vehicle Insurance** - Class 2 & 3 training vehicles must be insured with third-party liability coverage of at least \$1 million and must carry All Purpose insurance use.
- Certificate of Inspection (COI)** - Class 2 & 3 training vehicles require a COI which is dated no more than 6 months prior to applying for a new permit. The pink or yellow copy must be submitted with the application.
- NVIS (New Vehicle Information/Identification Statement)** - If your vehicle is brand new, instead of the COI, you may provide the New Vehicle Information (Identification) Statement (NIVIS). The date of sale must be indicated on the NVIS and cannot be more than 12 months prior to submitting your application.
- Training Vehicle Equipment**

Class 2 & 3 vehicles require:

- A sign that is firmly attached to the top or rear of the vehicle (trailer) and clearly visible from at least 20 metres behind the vehicle.
 - The sign must contain the words TRAINING VEHICLE, TRAINING CAR, or STUDENT DRIVER in upper case letters at least 20 centimetres in height.
- The name of the training school to be displayed on both sides of the vehicle in upper case letters at least 10 centimetres in height.
- The colour of all lettering and background must be contrasting shades.

Note: Facilities, equipment, vehicles and instructor permits are subject to inspection/validation prior to approval.
